

Role of Ordinary Council Member (Without Portfolio) of the British Congenital Cardiac Association

The Council advises on issues relating to matters of public or professional interest involving the advancement of health and education in all aspects of congenital cardiac diseases in the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland.

Elected members of Council represent the BCCA membership at Council meetings and may be elected to represent specific constituencies.

Elected Council members are expected to engage in the work of the Association through the Council meetings, ad hoc working groups and other projects as directed by the President and the Officers as appropriate. Council meets four times a year (at least 75% attendance is expected) and elected members serve a term of two years, renewable for a further two year subject to re-election. Elected Council members serve a term of two years, renewable for a further two year further two-year term subject to re-election.
